SITE COODINATORS IMPORTANT ITEMS

Responsibilities Include:

1) General Responsibilities:

- * Greet ALL coaches as they enter the gym,
- * Inspect all scoresheets as they must be filled out completely,
- * Check Team Roster.
- * Crowd Control (Parent/Spectator Problems),
- * Keep record of all scores.
- * Fill out forms for ejections and fights.

2) **Download Gym Schedules from njbl.org website**

3) **Reporting Scores - ***** Phone in all Scores**

- * Same procedure as above.
- * Type in scores and save via computer.

4) Assign **two (2) scorekeepers** for each game.

REPORTING SCORES and DOWLOADING GYM SCHEDULES VIA THE COMPUTER

Use the following process to enter scores online and accessing scoresheets:

1) Go to the Summer Tournament Home Page and find the Score Keepers Log In on the right side of the page and click on it

2) Role is Score Keeper. Type in Username: **scorekeeper** and Password: **allnet** then click on Login

3) Enter the date and pick your gym from the drop box and click go

4) To print out scoresheets for each game put a check in the box to the left of each team and click on PDF Game Card at bottom of page - Print the scoresheets

5) Scores are entered in the box's to the right of each team and then save

SCORE PHONE-IN PROCEDURES

Tournament: Summer League Tournament

Before Each Game:

***very important - If the teams names are not listed in your schedule you must correctly identify which team is the home team and which is the away team. Ask the teams that are playing which is home and which is away. Misidentification will lead to the wrong teams advancing to the next games in the schedule.**

After Each Game:

UPDATE SCORES BY PHONE

Scores for you tournament can be updated from any telephone, including mobile phones

CALL THIS NUMBER: **1-888-312-3011**

LISTEN TO THE WELCOME MESSAGE

***Press 0** at any time to start over.

***Press 1** to enter scores.

STEPS:

1. ENTER LEAGUE ID# **1387**
2. ENTER GAME ID# (found on the far left of schedule)
 - Go to the League/Tournament site
 - Click on Schedule
 - Select the Division using the drop down menu
 - The ID # is located on far left under "ID"
 - The ID # is **FIRST SIX DIGITS**
3. ENTER HOME TEAMS SCORE
4. ENTER AWAY TEAMS SCORE
5. REPEAT STEPS 1-4 TO REPORT ANY OTHER SCORES

Common Questions:

Q: How do i know if my score was reported properly?

A: You will Hear "Thank you your score has been reported".

Q: I made a mistake with reporting the wrong/incorrect Scores?

A: Call the system back and repeat steps 1-4 with the correct Information

GENERAL INFORMATION

A Few Reminders

1. All coaches will be required to stay in the coaches' box during the contest.
2. All players must be in proper uniform. T-shirts must match the main color of the uniform.
3. Referees and coaches will meet prior to each contest to cover specific rules and the Blue Card.
4. Excellent sportsmanship will be required during the tournament. Coaches must behave in a positive manner at all times. The head coach is responsible for his fans at the gymnasium.
5. All players must be on the roster and certified in order to participate.

Tournament Fee

All spectators must pay once daily to view tournament

DAILY CHARGE -

Players in uniform, the Head Coach and a maximum of 2 assistant coaches will enter free. Gate fee is good for the full day at any NJB Facility.

SUMMER LEAGUE TOURNAMENT RULES

RULES OF PLAY: NJB All-Net follows CIF High School rules.

LENGTH OF PLAYING TIME: ALL games will consist of four (4) eight-minute STOP TIME periods.

FORFEITS: If you forfeit a game, you may be restricted from playing your next league game, pending the decision of the Disciplinary Committee.

HALFTIME: Three minutes in duration.

OVERTIME PERIODS: The first overtime period will be three (3) minutes in duration. Additional overtime periods shall be two (2) minutes in duration, regulation stop time clock.

TIME-OUTS: Each team will be allowed three (3) full and two (2) 30-second time-outs in each game. One time-out will be granted to each team for each overtime period (no carry-over in time outs).

BENCH PERSONNEL: Only players whose names appear on the roster may sit on the bench.

FREE-THROW BONUS RULE: Teams will shoot the one-and-one-bonus on the 7th team foul in both halves. Double bonus will be awarded on the 10th team foul.

EJECTIONS: If a Team Coach, Assistant Coach, or Spectator is ejected from a game, he/she will be suspended for (AT LEAST) ONE FULL GAME, (the next scheduled game) and will not be allowed on the property of the gymnasium. If this rule is violated, please bring it to the attention of the gym supervisor. It is the responsibility of the Coach, Assistant Coach, or Team/Parent Representative to insure the ejected adult or athlete does not enter the property of the gymnasium. If this rule is violated, additional sanctions may be applied by the NJB Disciplinary Committee.

CONDUCT OF PLAYERS: The Head Coach is responsible for the actions of his/her players and spectators. Players and parents will be responsible for any damages incurred during the event. The Official Blue Card will be enforced in all divisions.

(NEW RULE) MERCY RULE: If team has a 20-point lead during the FOURTH QUARTER, the mercy rule will go into effect. The scorekeeper should notify the game referees of the 20-point lead. The team will not be allowed to employ a full-court press and must be allowed to cross the half court line. It is recommended that top players be removed and the substitutes play. A zone defense is recommended. The clock will become a running clock at all times until the point difference is 15 points or less, except for time-outs. The clock will become a regular clock if the point difference reaches 15 points or less.

PROTEST: All protests MUST be registered BEFORE the start of the game.

BALL SIZE: Boys 4th, 5th, 6th and ALL Girls divisions will use the 28.5" NJB Composite ball. Boys 7th and 8th will use the 29.5" NJB Composite ball.

SUMMER LEAGUE TOURNAMENT RULES

MEMBERSHIP: All players and coaches **MUST** be a current NJB member.

GAME BALLS: Teams must provide their own basketballs during warm-ups. Rawlings, the official composition ball of NJB shall be the official game ball. If the host site does not have a ball, the Home Team will have the first opportunity to supply the ball.

UNIFORMS:

1. Team shirts shall be of the same solid color front and back. Shirts shall be tucked inside the game pants.
2. Team shorts shall be alike for ALL players.
3. An undershirt is considered to be part of the shirts and must be a color identical to the shirt. An illegal undershirt may not be worn.
4. The official NJB logo shall be required on the front of the jersey.
5. Each player shall be numbered on the front (at least 4" high) and back (at least 6" high) of the shirt with plain Arabic numbers.
6. Sponsors names are permitted so long as placed in a fashion that does not obstruct the uniform number and chapter name. Please consult with NJB HQ.

HOME & VISITOR: The team listed on the left of the game bracket will be the home team and shall wear white or light colored jerseys. The team listed on the right of the game bracket will be the visitor team and shall wear dark colored jerseys. The Home team shall sit at the right side of the scorer's table and take the opposite basket for warm-ups and first-half play.

SUMMER LEAGUE TOURNAMENT PARNET SUPPORT / CONDUCT

THE GAME IS FOR OUR YOUNGSTERS. WE NEED YOUR FULL COOPERATION AND HELP IN PROVIDING GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP AND RESPECT.

- 1.) Spectators are not allowed to harass or openly criticize the referees. Verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
- 2.) Spectators should not harass or berate members of the opposing team, nor should they belittle their efforts.
- 3.) Spectators should cheer and encourage their team. They should be supportive of their team in victory and likewise to defeat.

Remember, it is just a game and should be fun for all. Spectators will be asked to leave the facility if their behavior does not represent good sportsmanship and respect.

OFFICIAL BLUE CARD

Referees are required to give this card to the Head Coach when adult sportsmanship is not up to NJB standards, according to our Mission Statement. Poor sportsmanship includes: ALL coaches and team fans!

(Exception: Team Players)

After the official warning at the coaches/referee pre-game, the following will happen:

- 1) 1st Infraction - One (1) Technical Foul goes directly to the Head Coach.
- 2) 2nd Infraction - Two (2) Technical Fouls and the Head Coach is removed from the gymnasium.
- 3) 3rd Infraction - The game is over AND the offending team is placed on immediate suspension.

GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP IS ALWAYS FIRST!!

T I E B R E A K E R :

In a situation where two (2) teams are tied, head to head competition will determine the winner. If more than two (2) teams are tied, a point differential (maximum of 13 points) will be applied. The differentials of each game are totaled and the teams are ranked accordingly. The team with the lowest total is eliminated, and will finish in third place. Then the winner from the remaining two (2) teams are determined by Head-to-Head competition.
